THE LITTLE CAT THAT COULD

When Peggy, a one month old kitten, arrived at CCHS she was a pathetic sight. She weighed less than three-quarters of a pound. We don't know how she was injured, but her left hind leg appeared to be broken and her pelvis and right hind leg were off-kilter as well. She was soaked with urine and our staff suspected she was paralyzed and lacked bladder control. Despite all this, Peggy had a spark! If she was on her last two legs, she didn't get the memo.



We also had hope for Peggy because she had a good appetite and did not appear to be in pain. She was affectionate and purred readily. We thus decided to set her up as comfortably as possible for the night, and see how she was doing in the morning.

We arrived the next morning and noticed that Peggy had used her litterbox! This was an excellent sign that she could control her bladder. The Medical Staff then decided that the best course of action was to place Peggy in foster care until she gained some weight. Assuming she did well, we would re-evaluate her when she was closer to two pounds.

Peggy thrived in her foster home! While the left rear leg continued to be problematic, Peggy didn't ask for sympathy. She zoomed around her foster home, dragging her hind legs behind her. She appeared to be a very happy cat.


We ultimately determined that Peggy's left rear leg was holding her back from leading a fully mobile life, so almost 2 months after her arrival at CCHS, the leg was amputated. Peggy returned to foster care for recovery and rehabilitation. Her devoted foster mom took a video of Peggy that we posted on the CCHS Facebook page. When Peggy came back to CCHS to go up for adoption, she was adopted right away by a family who saw her video and knew she would be a good fit.

Peggy is now thriving in her forever home!
